They are:

Also all lights are on motion sensor, if the lights are on in the clubhouse and everyone is out on the lawns, they will go off after twenty minutes. However as soon as someone re-enters the clubhouse, they will come back on. This applies to the toilets and all internal areas.

There is a new hot and chilled water filter tap on the kitchen sink for hot and cold drinks.

Please do not attempt to unpack any more boxes that are still inside the clubhouse, the committees are aware of them and they will be dealt with over the coming weeks. However, if there are any malfunctions in any new taps, toilets or equipment that has been recently installed, please let me know.
