

CONDITIONS OF PLAY GOLF CROQUET INDIVIDUAL COMPETITIONS

Players must arrive at least 30 minutes before starting time to assist with setting up of courts.

Hoops are to be set at 3^{3/4}' except for Gold Medal, State Championships and State qualifying events, for which they are to be set at 3^{11/16}'.

Handicap cards are to be produced at the beginning and end of the tournament.

WCF 2007 rules apply. If there is a dispute over a rule (or the conditions of play), the clock is to be stopped, the Rules or these Conditions consulted, agreement reached, and the clock and game restarted.

All games to be 13 point, level play, 45 minute limit EXCEPT for Gold Medal, State Championship and State Qualifying events which will be one hour. When time goes, a hoop that has been started (i.e. an opposition ball hit towards it after the previous hoop was scored) is to be finished. If scores are equal one further hoop is to be played.

Clips or pegs are to be used to ensure there is no dispute over scores. Refusal to do so will result in immediate disqualification.

In double banked games the second colours commence after the second hoop has been run by the first colours. Timers may be stopped temporarily if the game is delayed by the other players. If there is a game in progress when a second game is started then the second game gives way regardless of the colour of the balls.

All players are required to assist with managing the event and with the refereeing. If scheduled to manage a session do not leave the courts unless you have arranged for another person to take your place. As stated on the entry form for these events, failure to do so will result in disqualification.

All players are required to wash up any kitchen utensils they use and to ensure that the urn/jug is turned off at the end of the day.

Croquet SA's Hot Weather Policy applies.

Single game competition or double round robin winners will be determined on the number of games won. When these are equal it will be determined by net hoop points (hoops won less hoops conceded). If still equal, the winner will be decided by a single game playoff.

Best of Three competition winners will be determined on number of matches won. When these are equal it will be determined by net hoop points. If still equal, the winner will be decided by a single game playoff.

For competitions played in blocks the methods above shall be used to determine the winner of each block. Semi finals will be held. Winner of block 1 will play R/U block 2. Winner block 2 will play R/U block 1. Final will be played between winners of those games.
