PLAYING CONDITIONS

Club Team event open to players on **handicap 2.5 or higher**, but one player on handicap 2 may play.

Round robin of seven teams, (one bye for each team), played on Tuesday nights starting on **19th January** & finishing on 2nd March. Play has been programmed on a home & away basis, with each team having 3 home & 3 away games.

Each team to consist of 4 players arranged in 2 pairs in any handicap order. Each pair may also play as either first or second pair as desired on the night, except that if the 2 lowest handicaps in the team play together, then they must play as first pair.

Play must start by 7.00 p.m. Games must be double-banked, advanced play, 2.5 hours time limit, with a turn after the bell. If scores are tied at the end of play, then play must continue until the next point is scored. Players must always check the score before removing balls from the court.

A five-minute hit-up is always permitted.

Late Starts: If a team is more than fifteen minutes late the opposing team may claim a forfeit, but may agree to play shortened games if desired by both teams, provided that playing time for each game will be at least 1.5 hours & that play can finish not later than 10.15 p.m. Similarly, if one pair is late the opposing pair may claim a forfeit or negotiate for a shortened game as outlined above. If two players not designated as partners are late, then the two players present must form a pair so the match can start on time, with the late-comers playing together or forfeiting as required above. If one player is late, then that game must play second & must be started as soon as possible by the partner choosing a striker's ball & placing the other ball on a baulk line at the appropriate time. This ball is then in play & may be used as usual by any player, but may not be struck by them. When the late player arrives he/she may join in at an appropriate time by playing the designated ball from wherever it lies.

Visiting team must pay \$12 (\$3/player) to Home team. Home team must provide water & supper (coffee/tea, biscuits, etc.) to have during play.

Games may only be rescheduled for light failure, flooded or damaged lawns, stolen or vandalised equipment, or medical emergency on the night. Lightning & torrential rain are occasions for leaving the lawn &, if persistent for more than half an hour, are an acceptable reason for rescheduling. If match has proceeded for half an hour before the need to reschedule, then it must be pegged down & same players must continue it within two weeks. If playing time has been less than half an hour, then match will be completely rescheduled. **Inability to field a team is not an acceptable reason for rescheduling** - team must promote a player or import a player from another club. Such player may not have played for any other team in this competition &, if imported, must have written clearance from his/her own club. (If necessary, clearance may be verbal at the time, but followed up by a properly completed Clearance Form which must be sent to the event manager for filing).
