As of 1 January 2015 the Australian Croquet Association (ACA) adopted the Official Rulings 2015 of the WCF GC Rules 2013 updated 1 January 2016.

Not all the Rules have been addressed, only a select number which have been identified by Players and GC Referees as Rules that may be more important to players in the short term.
