



APPEALS PROCESS FOR ASSOCIATION AND GOLF CROQUET

- 1** *Published 3rd June 2014, and replaces all other appeals processes for Association and Golf Croquet in the Croquet SA regulations.*

- 2. APPEALS PROCESS**
All players have the right to appeal non selection on the basis that:
 - The Selection Policy has not been correctly followed or
 - The laws of Natural Justice have been violated or
 - The laws of the Land have been violated.

- 3** All appeals will be considered by an Appeals Committee of 3 persons appointed by the Board of Croquet SA.

- 4** A player appealing non-selection may in the first instance ask the chair of the selection committee the reasons for their non-selection, within seven (7) days of the notification of selections.

- 5** If so asked the chair of the selection committee must provide the appellant with 'written' reasons for non-selection within ten (10) days of the notification of selections.

- 6** If the player wishes to proceed with his or her appeal, they must, within fourteen (14) days of the notification of selections:-
 - Provide the selection committee with detailed grounds of the appeal.
 - Advise the Board of Croquet SA of their appeal, and
 - Pay an appeal fee of \$100 to Croquet SA.

- 7** Announcement of members of the State Teams will be subject to any appeals.

- 8** The Appeal Committee may hear and determine the appeal in such manner as it seems fit.

- 9** The Appeal Committee shall advise the appellant and the Selection sub-committee of its decision and provide reasons in writing for its decision and if it allows the appeal it,
 - shall return the matter to the Selection sub-committee for reconsideration, and
 - may give the Selection sub-committee directions as to how the Selection sub-committee should proceed with the selection.

- 10** Croquet SA shall return the appeal fee in full to a successful appellant and if the Appeal Committee so recommends, may return part or the whole of the appeal fee to an unsuccessful appellant.
