6.4 During events have discretion to make non-automatic handicap changes for any player if their improvement is outpacing progress on their card. Any such changes shall be effective immediately. (The ACA Golf Croquet Handicapping Regulations 6.4)

State Handicappers shall fulfil the role of National Handicapper as it is described in Point 6 of the Appendix to The Rules of Golf Croquet, 2013 entitled "Regulations for an Automatic Handicap System. (The ACA Golf Croquet Handicapping Regulations 4)

Club GC Handicapper

The functions of the Club GC Handicapper would include:.....

7.3 Watch for players whose improvement is outpacing progress on the card and recommend to the National Handicapper (Substitute State Handicapper) that a decrease in handicap be applied.

7.4 Listen to requests for handicap extensions and make recommendations to the National GC Handicapper (Substitute State Handicapper). . . normally . . . granted only for a player returning to croquet after ill health. (Appendix to The Rules of Golf Croquet, 2013)
