ALTERNATE STROKE HANDICAP DOUBLES

- AC Laws 48 and 50 apply.
- The games are played as Ordinary Level Doubles Play. In other words, no lift or contact.
- The players of each side play alternate strokes throughout each side's turn and from one turn to the next. If Player A played the last stroke when a turn ended, then at the start of their next turn, Player B must play the first stroke. They can start the next turn with either of their balls. You will be provided with a badge to pass to your partner at the end of a turn to help remember who is to start the next turn.
- If it cannot be remembered who was to play the first stroke of the next turn, then the opposing side will decide who will play the first stroke.
- When taking a bisque, the order of turns must be preserved. In other words, if Player A plays a stroke and a bisque is taken, then Player B must play the bisque stroke. If a subsequent bisque is then taken, Player A must play the next stroke, and so on...
- Playing out of sequence is an error. If any player in the game notices that a player is about to play out of turn, they must forestall play immediately. If the error is discovered before the limit of claims (3rd stroke in error) and no other turn-ending events have occurred, the player who should have started the turn plays the next stroke. If the error is discovered after the limit of claims, then the sequence of play becomes the new sequence of play.
- As in normal Handicap Play, the number of bisques given is half the difference in the combined handicaps of each side. A quarter is rounded up to a half bisque, and three quarters is rounded up to a full bisque.
